



YOUTH INTERVENTION PROGRAM

The Youth Intervention Program is offered to any youth in Midland County that may be in need of mental health services.

The Youth Intervention Specialist, a Master's level clinician, would complete a mental health screening during a face-to-face contact. Results of the screening would be shared with the youth and his/her parent.

The Youth Intervention Specialist would then help link the youth with the appropriate services. Youth can be referred for many different reasons, including: Substance Use; Suspension Reductions; Crisis Assessments; Anger/Aggression; Defiance/Disruptive Behavior; Depression/Anxiety; Problematic Sexual Behavior; Self-harm/Suicidal Thinking; Eating Disorders; Trauma; LGBTQIA+ related issues; Frequent law enforcement interactions.

This is a free service. The Youth Intervention Program starts with meeting a Youth Intervention Specialist at school, court, or other office to complete a screening. The first encounter typically lasts 45 minutes.
